* Piña Colada Kebabs * (July 10th Food Craft) Ingredients


- 1 pineapple
- 1 can cream of coconut (cold)
- 1/2 cup heavy whipping cream
- 1/4 cup powdered sugar
- 1 cup toasted shredded coconut
- maraschino cherries

<u>Instructions</u>

- 1. Chop pineapple into bite size cubes and set aside.
- 2. In a large bowl, combine cream of coconut, heavy cream, and powdered sugar. Beat with mixer until fluffy and soft peaks hold, about 3 minutes.
- 3. Using a toothpick, skewer a maraschino cherry then a pineapple cube. (You can add more cherries to your taste depending on how many cherries to pieces of coconut you have.) Dip the bottom of the pineapple into the coconut cream mixture, then dip in shredded coconut to coat.
- 4. Enjoy immediately or refrigerate until ready to serve.
