#### **Ingredients**

- \* 1 box yellow cake mix
- \* 2 eggs
- \* 1/2 cup oil
- \* 1 cup peanut butter (creamy)
- \* Jar of desired jelly/jam flavor
- \* Milk of your preference

# Peanut Butter & Jelly Thumbprint Cookies Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. In a large bowl, mix together eggs, oil, and peanut butter until completely smooth.
- 3. Slowly add in dry cake mix a little at a time to peanut butter

mixture. Combine until you get thick cookie dough consistency. (Do not overmix.)

- 4. Roll dough into one-inch balls and place separated 2-3 inches apart on a parchment lined baking sheet.
- 5. Press thumb into center of each dough ball making a crater indent.
- 6. Fill crater in center of each cookie with a small scoop of jelly/jam.
- 7. Bake for 12-15 minutes or until slightly brown.
- 8. Allow cookies to cool 10-15 minutes on rack.
- 9. Enjoy with a tall glass of cold milk. (Almond, soy, classic, or chocolate... Milk just goes with PB&J!)
