# **Chunky Monkey Cookies** (December 14th Activity)

#### **Ingredients**

- 2 ripe mashed bananas
- 1 box cake mix
- 1 (3.4 oz) box banana cream pudding mix
- 2 eggs
- 1/3 cup melted butter
- 1 tablespoon milk
- 1 cup chocolate chips
- 1/2 cup chopped walnuts **Instructions**
- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. In a large bowl whisk together cake mix & pudding mix and put aside. (Do not prepare the pudding; leave it dry.)

- 3. In separate bowl combine butter, bananas, milk, and eggs.
- 4. Marry the wet and dry mixes in large bowl.
- 5. Fold in chocolate chips & walnuts into dough.
- 6. Scoop out cookie dough into 2 tbsp-size balls and arrange on parchment-lined baking sheet. (Leave space for expansion.)
- 7. Bake cookies for 10-13 minutes, or until set.
- 8. Allow cookies to cool for 15-20 minutes before serving.
- 9. Enjoy!
