Update on Visitation Guidelines

For family members or friends of our Residents wishing to conduct INDOOR VISITS:

- You must provide proof of being fully vaccinated (1st Dose and 14 days after 2nd Dose is considered fully vaccinated) AND provide evidence of a negative COVID test within one day of visitation of the antigen test, and within two days of PCR test.
- For family members or friends of our Residents that are not vaccinated or not completely vaccinated, you are eligible only for OUTDOOR visitation as long as you provide evidence of a negative COVID test within one day of visitation of the antigen test, and within two days of PCR test. Masks are to be worn properly at all times.
- For visitors who visit for multiple consecutive days, proof of negative test is only required every third day (meaning testing is only required on day 1, day 4, day 7, and so on).

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and we look forward to getting back to normal. Together we WILL all get through this!

Bananas Foster Muffins (February 23rd Activity)

Ingredients

- 4 bananas (3 ripe, 1 yellow)
- 1 box yellow cake mix
- 2 large eggs
- 3 tbsp butter
- 1/2 cup brown sugar
- 1/2 tsp cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon rum extract
- 1 cup chopped pecans **Instructions**
- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
- 2. Combine the butter, brown sugar, and cinnamon in skillet.
- 3. Cook on low heat, stirring, until sugar dissolves. Add cut yellow banana (1/2 inch slices)

to pan and turn heat up until melted sugar is bubbling slowly.

- 4. Remove from the heat, add pecans & rum extract. Stir well. Set aside, allow to cool slightly.
- 5. Meanwhile in a large bowl, combine mashed remaining bananas, eggs, and cake mix. Stir until mixed. Gently fold the banana sugar mixture into the batter. Divide into thoroughly buttered 12-cup muffin tin.
- 6. Bake 20 minutes.
- 7. Cool for five minutes in muffin tin before transferring to a rack.
